Course Description

The course aims to provide participants with knowledge in the area of Liturgical Ministry. An interdisciplinary approach considering the human, theological, spiritual and pastoral disciplines which will facilitate the congregation dynamics in worship.

Target Group

The course will be offered to all people who are interested in Liturgical Formation. It will be offered to persons that work, or are interested to work, in pastoral settings.

Course Objectives

Participants will be able to:

- a) understand the liturgical concepts
- b) animate liturgical services
- c) accompany the congregation in their worship
- d) enhance their public speaking skills
- e) develop a proactive environment for worship
- f) interpret the liturgical symbols and gestures
- g) share the skills and knowledge acquired with the congregation
